

## Year 6 Curriculum Focus Summer Term 2023

### English

This term pupils will be looking at informative writing and different ways of presenting information using a range of non-fiction text (Chronological & non-chronological reports). We will continue to develop comprehension skills and using the Answer, Prove, Explain chain.

### Science

Sets 1 and 2 will focus on the topics of light, microorganisms and electricity.

Set 3 will focus on the topics of humans as organisms, microorganisms and electricity.

### Maths

Set 1 will complete the 13+ Core Common Entrance syllabus and review the topics covered: focussing on algebra - expressions and equations; decimals, fractions, percentages and ratio. Circle work. Coordinate Graphs and Transformations. Sequences.

Set 2 will study core number work and consolidation of calculation skills; fractions, decimals and percentages; number sequences and nth term rule; area, perimeter and volume including circles; angles; reading and interpreting graphs; Theme Park project.

Set 3 will study core number work and consolidation of calculation skills; fractions, decimals and percentages; area, perimeter and volume of 2D shapes; missing angles in shapes; ratio; algebra; reading and interpreting graphs.

### French

This term lessons will cover the topic of holidays, transport, activities and a recap of weather. Pupils will also begin revision and the study of irregular verbs.

### Spanish

Pupils will study the topics family and friends, personal and family descriptions and will also be prepared for the school assessments at the end of term.

### Latin

Pupils will begin to learn nominatives and accusatives singular and plurals, translation, numbers from one to ten and vocabulary.

### History

Throughout the term, pupils will cover The Black Death in medieval England, the Coronation of King Charles III, (the symbolism of the sceptre, orb and heraldic beasts as well as the history of the St Edward's and Imperial crowns).

### Geography

Pupils will study the topics of global location, naming countries and capitals within the continents of the world and understanding the major physical and manmade features within. The topic of our locality will involve looking at the local land use around Windlesham.

### Drama

Pupils will explore Victorian Melodrama, theatrical and historical context, performance conditions and archetypes.

### Music

Pupils will learn about the music of the Caribbean. Looking at the history of mento, calypso, ska and reggae, and taking on a practical project around the song Soul Limbo.

## Art

The summer term brings the study of fruit inspired art and pottery project, Cezanne, Arcimboldo, Laurel Burch patterned cats.

## Design technology

Pupils will create LED lights and learn to solder circuits.

## Food technology

This term will focus on the preparation for the fine dining evenings, finessing the dishes that will be presented to parents.

## Games

This term pupils will play cricket and compete in a full schedule of fixtures, they will evaluate play in terms of technique and how to improve for each match.

## PE

Pupils will spend the summer term focussing on athletics building on their technique and improving their performance in preparation for sports day.

## Computing

Variables in games - The students will explore the concept of variables in programming through games in Scratch. Sound Editing - Students will learn how sound is digitized and stored on computers.

## Study Skills

For those pupils who will take Pre-tests in Year 7, we will focus on specific practice for these. Pupils will also cover guidance and learn skills about how to study and exam preparation: Mind maps, lists, mnemonics, revision techniques.

## PSHE

Pupils will learn more about mental health and how to take care of their own mental well-being. They will investigate online safety, learning how to judge if something is safe and helpful, in addition to talking about communicating with friends and family in a positive and safe way.
