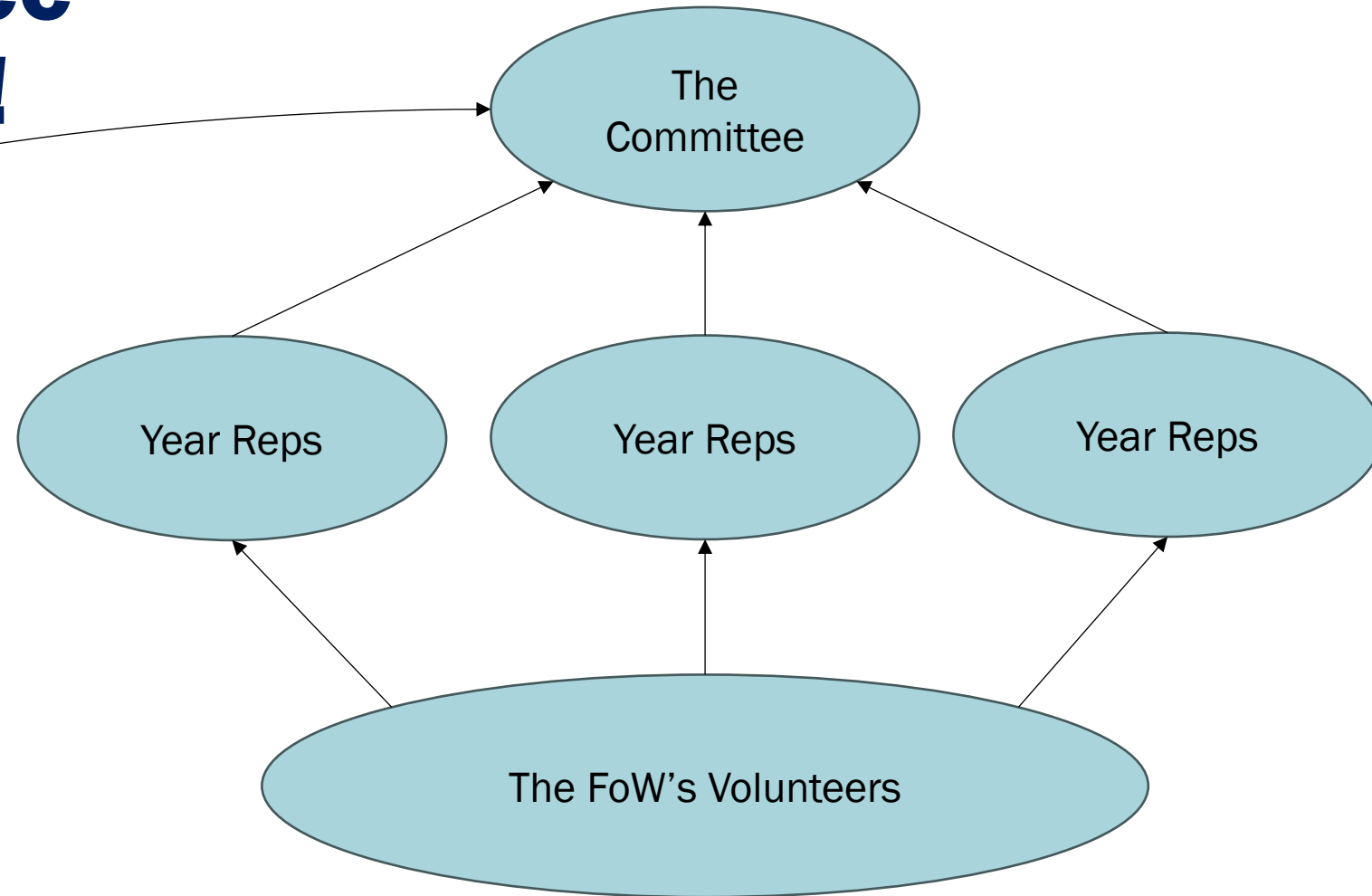

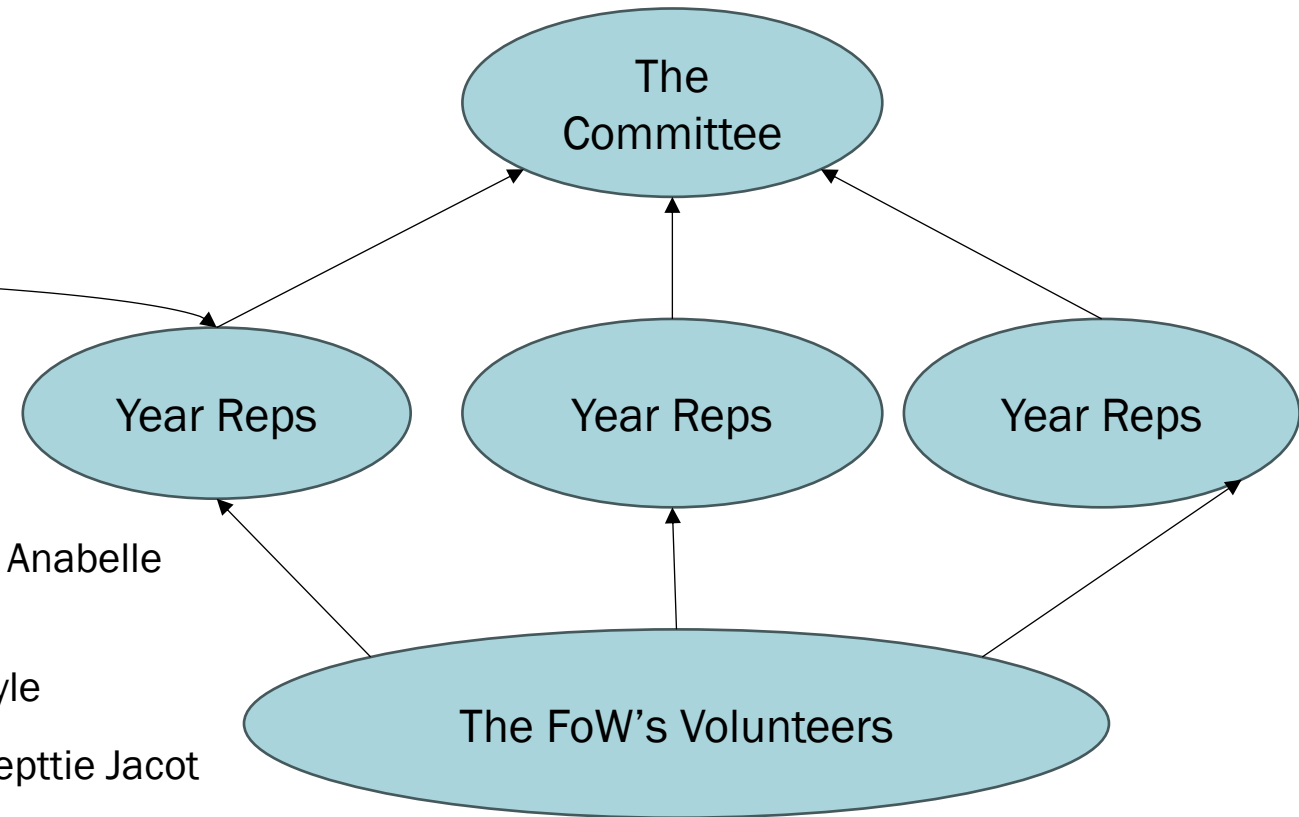

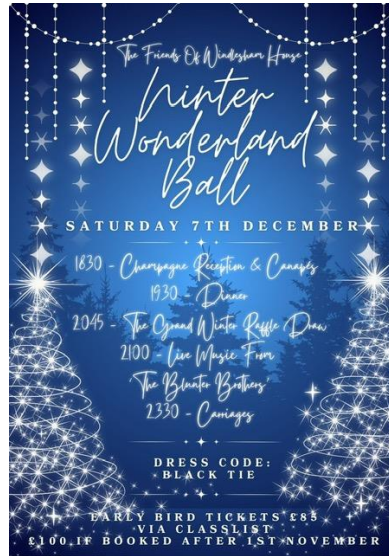




# Winter Ball
